

Introducing the Concentric Network

The Concentric Network offers four new plans, which provide a distinct PCP network and richer member benefits. The Concentric Network is based on provider groups focused on efficiency.

How Does the Concentric Network Work?

Highlights of the Concentric Network plans include:

- Targeted PCP network.
- A provider in the Concentric Network can participate in **all** plans in a service area, while non-concentric providers can only participate in non-concentric plans in the service area.
- Concentric Network Plans offer more benefits including:
 - Personal Care Plus, a gift card for approved over-the-counter items at participating pharmacies.
 - Lower member cost sharing for certain services.

Concentric Network Plans

The new plans (highlighted below) are based on Concentric Networks of PCPs within Dade and Pinellas counties. All contracted specialists, facilities and ancillary providers within these service areas will be available to members of the Concentric Network plans.

Membership

Existing members who have PCPs who are a part of the Concentric Network will **not** automatically default into one of the new plans upon 2008 renewal. Members may choose to disenroll from their renewal plan and re-enroll in a new Concentric Network plan during the Annual Election Period, the Open Enrollment Period, or if they qualify for a Special Election Period.

New members who enroll in a Concentric Network plan may only switch to a non-concentric plan during these same periods. The Medicare lock-in provision applies to members of the Concentric Network plans.
