



Well √ Check Program

The Well √ Check Program provides medical, hearing, vision and dental check-ups. It follows the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP)/Bright Futures Guidelines. The goals of the Well √ Check Program are to assure that health problems are diagnosed and treated as early as possible, and that medically justified services are provided before the problems become complex or treatment becomes more costly. All states that participate in the Medicaid program must offer **Early Periodic Screening Diagnosis Treatment (EPSDT)** to all children enrolled in Medicaid under the age of 21.

State approved forms will be requested in lieu of medical records for Healthcare Effectiveness Data & Information Set (HEDIS®) review. If the forms are not utilized in your office, you will be required to submit the full medical record for review.

EPSDT services include:

- Screening/Well Child check-ups, lead testing and immunizations; and
- Other treatment services to correct a medical condition, make it better or prevent the child's health status from worsening.

Minimal required services for EPSDT include:

- Preventive screenings
 - Preventive laboratory services
 - Developmental/behavioral assessment
- Lead testing at 12 and 24 months
- Immunizations
 - Referral to a dentist at age 3

EPSDT Schedule:

- Neonatal Exam
- Under 6 weeks
- 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 9 months
- 12 months
- 15 months
- 18 months
- 2 years
- 3 years
- 4 years
- 5 years
- Annually from age 6 through 21
