Harmony Health Plan Rolls Out Mobile Wellness Center

TAMPA, Fla. (May 9, 2007) – Harmony Health Plan, part of the WellCare family of health plans (NYSE:WCG), recently unveiled their new Mobile Wellness Center. More than 70 community leaders were at the ribbon cutting ceremony at the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Center in East St. Louis.

Continuing its commitment to bring healthcare closer to the community, Harmony will use a specially outfitted RV to provide health screenings and evaluations at schools, day care centers, housing developments, health fairs and community events. The Mobile Wellness Center will also be used to provide health education information throughout the region.

Upcoming events include the Annual Power to End Stroke with the American Heart Association Health Fair, CHIPS Annual Walk Run, Annual Annie Malone May Day Parade on May 20, and the East St. Louis Community Health Fair on May 26. Harmony will also conduct monthly "Health Screenings on the GO" with the assistance of CHIPS (Community Health in Partnership Services) and St. Louis University.

“Our Mobile Wellness Center will further our mission of delivering the message of health and wellness to the community,” said Tina Gallagher, Harmony Health Plan’s executive director of the Southern Illinois region. “We are especially looking forward to working with the schools to implement health education days.”

Prior to the ribbon cutting ceremony, East St. Louis Mayor Carl Officer issued a proclamation declaring April as “Harmony/WellCare and Community Partners Health Education, Wellness and Prevention Month.” The proclamation cited Harmony’s work to improve access to healthcare through community partnerships, its work with area physicians, and its active participation in community activities throughout the region.

“This really is a celebration of collaboration between Harmony and great partners such as the Jackie Joyner-Kersey Center, East St. Louis School District, Salvation Army, Urban League, Illinois Asthma Camps, CHIPS, Christian Activity Center and Southern Illinois Regional Wellness Center (SIRWC),” stated Gallagher. “With more than one hundred partnerships, it is really hard to mention them all, but each is equally important to us in helping build a healthy community.”
