

Initiation and Engagement of Alcohol and Drug Treatment (IET)

The National Benchmark to measure the Initiation and Engagement of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse or Dependence Treatment (IET) is as follows:

The percentage of adolescent and adult members with a new episode of alcohol or other drug (AOD) abuse or dependence who received the following:


✓ Initiation of AOD Treatment. The percentage of members who initiate treatment through an inpatient AOD admission, outpatient visit, intensive outpatient encounter or partial hospitalization, telehealth or medication treatment within 14 days of the diagnosis.

Engagement of AOD Treatment. The percentage of members who initiated treatment and who had two or more additional AOD services or medication treatment within 34 days of the initiation visit.



"In 2020, it was estimated that 41.1 million people aged 12 or older needed substance abuse treatment. However, just 6.5% (2.6 million) received substance abuse treatment."¹

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How can you help?

- Ensure that you have completed the appropriate assessments and diagnosis indicating AOD treatment is needed.
- Educate member on the importance of treatment and follow-up appointments within **14 days of diagnosis and two more appointments within 34 days**.
- Include member in all aftercare planning regarding scheduling follow up appointments and connecting them with community supports.
- Assist the member in addressing any barriers to attending follow-up appointments.
- Submit proper billing codes, refer to the codes listed below.
