



## Medication Review Crucial to Member Health Outcomes

### Did you know?

**Medication Reconciliation Post-Discharge (MRP):** This HEDIS measure ensures that members who are discharged from the hospital have their medications reviewed by a prescribing practitioner, clinical pharmacist or registered nurse within 30 days of discharge. An outpatient visit is not required, but is highly encouraged.

### What do you need to do?

- **Reach out** to your member and see them within 30 days of a discharge
- **Document** in the patient's chart indicating:
  - Member's discharge medications were reviewed with the current outpatient medications and/or
  - No medications were prescribed upon discharge
- **Send a claim** to WellCare for the services above. The suggested codes for these services include:
  - CPT Code 99495-99496: Transitional Care Management Services and
  - CPT II code 1111F: Medication Reconciliation

### What is WellCare doing?

- Our Discharge Planning, Pharmacy or Care Management Teams are attempting to reach out to your members and performing the Medication Reconciliation by phone.
- If we are successful in reaching your member, WellCare will fax you the results of this call. We ask that you include this fax in your medical record and review these medications with your member when you see them.
  - **Send a claim** to WellCare for the services above. The suggested codes for these services include:
    - CPT Code 99495-99496: Transitional Care Management Services and
    - CPT II code 1111F: Medication Reconciliation
